
- 1. If a cutting edge is already installed, remove the last two carriage bolts on the end of the blade. Retain any washers for reinstallation.
- 2. Hold the curb guard casting against the base of the blade. If the first two cutting edge holes on the blade are visible through the slot in the casting,



3. Insert a carriage bolt into the bolting bar. Use Slot 1 if the first hole in the blade is 4" or less from the edge of the blade. Use Slot 2 if the first hole is more than 4" from the edge. Continue passing the carriage bolt through the curb guard, spacer, blade and cutting edge (if present).



- 4. Put a locknut onto the carriage bolt and hand tighten. If a cutting edge was present, reinstall the washers retained when the cutting edge fasteners were removed.
- 5. If the bolting bar was trimmed, install another carriage bolt and spacer using Slot 2. If the bolting bar was not trimmed, install another carriage bolt using either Slot 3 or 4. Attach a locknut and hand tighten.
- Slide the casting inward until it is tight against the edge of the blade.
- 7. Tighten first carriage bolt then the second to 115 ft-lb.
