2004 & 2005 Ford F250-550 Blocker Beam

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
Ford Motor Company has made a design change in the bracket used to mount the vehicle Blocker Beam. This change will affect the mounting cartons:

EZ Mount Classic - 17112, 17113 and Diamond 81021 MDII / E-Z Mount Plus - 17122, 17142 & 17150 E-Z Mount Xpress - 17145

Identify which type Blocker Beam is on the vehicle:

Blocker Beam unbolts from the Brackets: It will be necessary to modify the brackets as follows. Cut inner tabs at end of brackets as close to the bend as possible. See Figure 1. NOTE: In the event that the snowplow mounting is removed from the vehicle is will be necessary to reinstall Blocker Beam to the vehicle frame. To remove Blocker Beam, abricate two pieces of 1/4" x 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" angle or equivalent material to replace the tabs that have been cut off.

Blocker Beam and Brackets are welded together: The one piece weldment assembly for the blocker beam is bolted to the bottom of the vehicle frame. See Figure 2. Unbolt the assembly from the frame of the vehicle. Do not discard. It will be necessary to reinstall if snow plow frame is removed.
