





INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Park the vehicle on a smooth, level, hard surface, such as concrete. Lower the blade to the ground, and turn the control OFF. Disconnect the snowplow from the vehicle according to the instructions on the back of the blade, or turn the vehicle ignition to the "OFF" position and remove the key.
- 2. Secure the blade guide rod to the outermost rib with two 5/16" x 1" cap screws and locknuts.
- 3. Torque both fasteners to 18 ft-lb.
- 4. Repeat Steps 2–3 for the opposite side.
