

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

A WARNING

Do not exceed GVWR or GAWR, including blade and ballast. The rating label is found on the driver-side vehicle door cornerpost.


Read this document before installing the rubber deflector.

Use standard methods and practices when attaching snowplow and installing accessories, including proper personal protective safety equipment.

A CAUTION


See your FISHER® outlet/Web site for specific vehicle application recommendations before installation. Rubber deflector weight information may be found in the eMatch selection system.

- Park the vehicle on a smooth, level, hard surface, such as concrete. Lower the blade to the ground, and turn the control OFF. Disconnect the snowplow from the vehicle or turn the vehicle ignition to the OFF position and remove the key.
- HD2[™] installations: Skip to Step 3.
 HDX[™] installations: Remove the existing fasteners along the top edge of the moldboard.
- Align the deflector on the blade, matching up the holes in the deflector with the holes in the top bar (HD2 snowplow) or moldboard (HDX snowplow). On 8-1/2' blades the deflector will extend beyond the ends of the blade.
- 4. Place the center deflector hold-down on top of the deflector, matching up the 4 holes in the hold-down with the 4 center holes on the deflector. Install the hold-down using one 3/8" button cap screw, two washers, and one locknut for each hole, as shown. Make sure the hold-down is tight against the deflector and moldboard or top bar.




10" Deflector and HD2™ Blade Shown

5. Align the outside edges of the driver-side and passenger-side deflector hold-downs with the outer ends of the blade. Install the hold downs using one 3/8" button cap screw, two washers, and one 3/8" locknut for each hole. Make sure the hold-downs are tight against the deflector and moldboard or top bar.



6. On 8-1/2' blades only: Trim excess length from both ends of the deflector, as shown.
